Q: **Will I have to preach?**

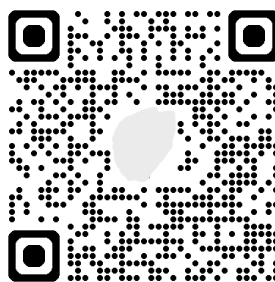
A: No, only if you are called to preach. We all have different gifts from God. Lay Servants can serve in many different ways,

A; We ask that you write a check to your home church for \$20. You will also need to buy your student book or e-book. Details are available at liedistrict.com/LayServantMinistries.

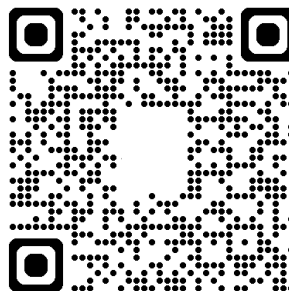
